

Pursuit Camp | Packing List

WHAT TO PACK:

- Bible, journal, pen, small bag or backpack to keep some things in for sessions, etc.
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Sleeping bag + pillow -OR- sheets, blanket, and pillow (twin size mattress)
- Summer clothes (compliant with Modesty Code)
 - Comfy shoes for walking around camp, closed-toe shoes/cleats for games
 - Clothes that are okay to get dirty in (wet, dirty, muddy, paint, we advise against wearing white or lighter color shirts for games as well so please wear other colors, etc.)
 - Day clothes, pajamas, etc.
 - Bathing suit (compliant with Modesty Code)
- Towel, shower shoes
- Toiletries (deodorant, toothbrush/toothpaste, shampoo/conditioner, body wash, etc.)
- Snacks for the cabin if you would like (protein bars, crackers, small packaged items - Peanut Free!)

MEDICATIONS

- IMPORTANT:** All prescribed medication must be turned in upon arrival. We encourage that your pharmacy pre-packages your needed dosages in packs if you're able to. If not, please bring all medication in it's ORIGINAL BOTTLE.
- You do not need to bring any over-the-counter medication as our nurses have a supply as needed. On your registration, you can indicate which OTC meds you are okay with your student having while at camp.

OPTIONAL

- Alarm Clock (**not on your phone**)
- Insect repellent
- Spending money for the snack shack (**suggested: \$15-20**)

WHAT TO NOT PACK:

- ANY electronic devices
 - No phones (youth leaders will have phones if needed)
 - If you bring a phone and would like to turn it in at registration, you can. Some students like to do this so that they can get their phones the last day to take photos. When they turn them in, we put them in bags and label them with their name and church. (**NOTE: We are NOT liable for ANY damages to any electronic device turned into us. We advise**

leaving them at home or with Parent/Guardians as the best course of action.)

- ❑ ALL leaders will be accessible to your student to be able to allow them to call you if needed. If you need to get in touch with your student, you may contact your Youth Pastor, Youth Director, or a youth leader. You can also always email us at thepursuitcamp@gmail.com to get in touch with the Camp Administrator who can help direct you to the right person.
- ❑ No cameras (This includes disposable and polaroid cameras. This is a safety precaution, especially in the cabins where use isn't as easily regulated. We will have photos taken all week by our media team and will make them available after camp. Photos can be taken after dismissal on Saturday when students receive their phones back.)
- ❑ Inappropriate reading material (books, Kindle readers, magazines, etc.)
- ❑ Illegal narcotics, tobacco, alcohol, vape pens, ecigs, etc.
- ❑ Weapons (knives, pocket knives, guns, tasers, lighters, matches, fireworks, etc.)
- ❑ Be mindful of bringing anything "expensive" like shoes, makeup, purses, etc. If you bring these and something happens to them, keep in mind that The Pursuit Camp is not liable to replace the item/s.
